



Minutes, January 20, 2018 Membership Meeting of the San Diego Chapter of the SAR

The San Diego Chapter of the SAR hosted the January Membership Meeting and Breakfast at the Broken Yolk Cafe at 11630 Carmel Mountain Rd, San Diego. The meeting was called to order by President Fred Hall at 9:00am. The invocation was offered through the singing by the members of "God Bless America." The Colors were then presented by the Color Guard. Color Guard Commander Ernie McCullough, Richard Palmer, Skip Cox and Bob Hayden made up the Color Guard. The members were led in the Pledge of Allegiance by 1st Vice President Barry Key and the Pledge to the SAR by member Bill Peters.


President Hall then administered the oath of office to newly elected officers.
