

129th National Congress Medal

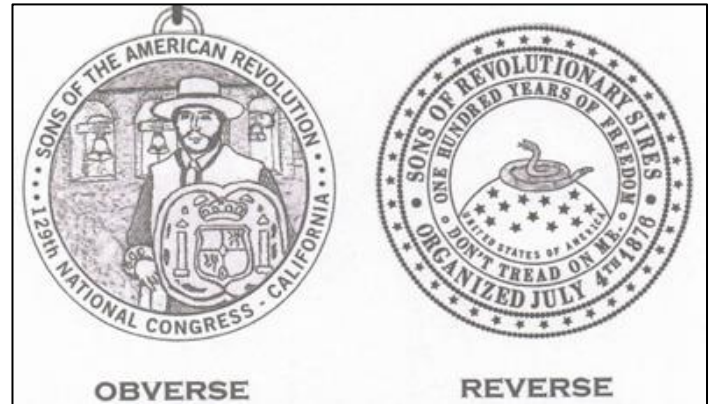
The California Society of the Sons of the American Revolution (CASSAR) is the host society for the 129th National Congress that will be held in 2019 at the Hilton Hotel in Costa Mesa, CA.



A 129th National Congress Medal has been struck for CASSAR and is now available for purchase. The medal set includes a large and miniature medal as depicted in the photograph to the left.

The image on the obverse is a Spanish soldado in front of a California Mission. This image reflects California's Spanish heritage and the role of Spain in supporting the colonies

during the American Revolution.



The image on the reverse of the medal is the seal of the Sons of Revolutionary Sires (SRS) founded in San Francisco in 1875 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. In 1899, twenty state organizations, including the SRS, held a meeting in New York City that led to the creation of the National Society, Sons of the American Revolution (NSSAR). In April 1890, prior to the 1st NSSAR Congress, the SRS changed its name to the California Society, Sons of the American Revolution.

The medal set can be purchased for \$35.00 and the CASSAR will use the proceeds from the sale of the medals to defray a portion of the expenses associated with serving as the Congress host society.
